Every December the *Strawbery Banke Museum*, in Portsmouth holds, its annual Candlelight Stroll for six evenings in December. The museum's *William Pitt Tavern* hosts dinners during the stroll on the Tavern's First Floor [prepared by the *Fezziwig's Food and Fountain of Pickwick's Mercantile*].
